


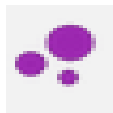
# SD71 ACCESSIBILITY TECH TIP



## Using Dom Distiller with Databases, Websites, e-text or computer program

**ABOUT:** In this activity, participants will learn how to use Dom Distiller (Distill) Extension (loaded on SD71 computers) with the District Databases, websites, e-text or any computer application. Dom Distiller (Distill) removes visual clutter from web pages and articles making them easier to read. It has built in options for changing the screen contrast and font types.

**WHAT YOU WILL NEED:** A computer with Google Chrome Browser and an internet connection with the Distill installed (If the Dom Distiller extensions is not installed click [HERE.](#)) You will know **Dom Distiller** is added because you will see three purple dots  in the upper right hand menu bar. (SD71 computers have **Dom Distiller** installed already)

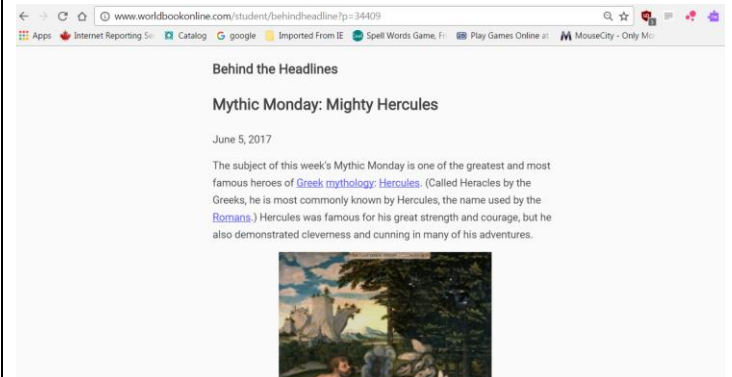

In Chrome open a text article that you want to read and click on the 3 purple dots.



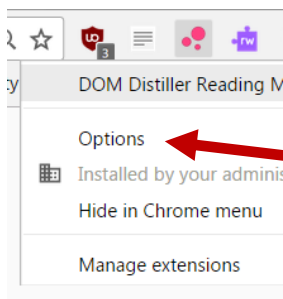
