

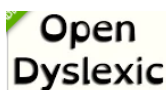

Using Open Dyslexic Font Extension with Databases, Websites, e-text

ABOUT: In this activity, participants will learn how to use **Open Dyslexic Font Extension** (needs to be added as a Chrome extension) with the District Databases, websites or e-text. Open Dyslexic Font Extension converts all text to the Open Dyslexic Font with heavier weighting for the letters that helps students who have difficulty processing text.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED: Open Dyslexic extension loaded on your computer in Google Chrome Browser and Databases, website or e-text open in Google Chrome. You can find the **Open Dyslexic Font Extension** [HERE](#), search for Open Dyslexic and click Add to Chrome.

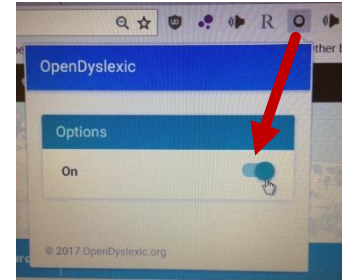
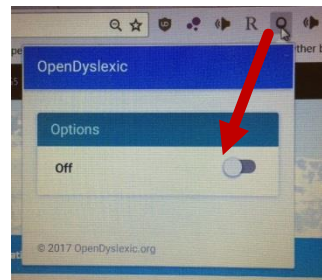


Research Databases

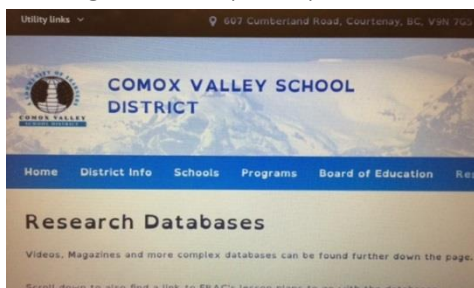
- 1** Locate the **Open Dyslexic Font** icon in the top right hand corner of the Google Chrome Browser tool bar by left clicking on the icon.



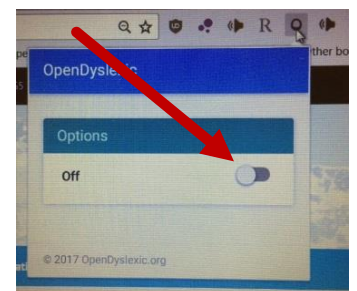
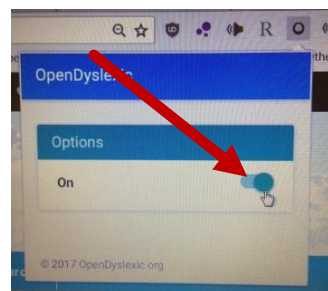
- 2** Turn on the Open Dyslexic Font by clicking the button to ON (to the right).



- 3** Once turned ON all of the text on a webpage, data base or in an e-text based online application will change to the Open Dyslexic font.



- 4** To Turn off Open Dyslexic Font extension click on the icon and click the on/ off button. The text will revert to the original text.
