

Administrative Procedure 6013
Ambulance Calls to Schools

It is recognized that situations arise where it is necessary that students be transported to a hospital or clinic for medical attention.

If transportation by ambulance is required, the board will accept billings for such service from the Ministry of Finance’s Emergency Health Services Commission.

Should the matter not be an emergency situation requiring an ambulance, and the student is driven to the hospital or clinic by the principal or other responsible staff member, the board will provide reimbursement, upon application, at current provincial kilometrage rates.

In either case, the principal or teacher in charge will attempt to notify parents prior to the service being provided; otherwise notification will be made as soon as possible afterwards.
